


- Lease is up in March 2021
- By state QSAC standards, our building is 33% too small.
- The Library hosted over 100 programs in 2018.
- Our available table space is frequently filled up.
- The children's area needs expansion for collections.
- During events, the library reaches occupancy limit.
- Adults lack a comfortable quiet space.
- Staff is in need of adequate space and storage.

SOLUTION

- Design & build a new library on donated property.
- Fund the design & construction without a hike in taxes through a combination of library savings & a loan.
