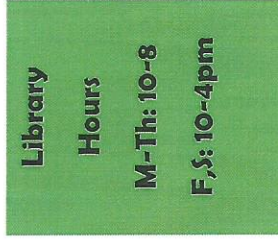
Fundraising Events:
