- Boundary, Topographic & Tree Survey
- Wetland Delineation, Report & Survey
- Concept Site Planning

The study and report for the beautiful, rolling 3.8 acre parcel will take about a month. N & F's findings will be shared with our architect, **John Danckaert** who has generously offered his services pro bono! The results of the investigations and site concept will give us the information to move forward.
